



“Seek the LORD, all you humble of the earth... seek righteousness, seek humility, perhaps you will be hidden in the day of the LORD’s anger.” Zephaniah 2:3

The humble are those who both live in God’s presence and are exalted by Him. (Isaiah 57:15; James 4:10). The humble are free from the inner drive to be noticed by men, approved by men or exalted by men. Their’s is a life of trust in Christ. Embrace Jesus today, even in the midst of His pain and suffering. “That I might know Him...and the fellowship of His suffering.” (Philippians 3:10).
