



“The LORD your God has increased your numbers so that today you are as many as the stars in the sky. May the LORD, the God of your fathers, increase you a thousand times and bless you as He has promised!” Deuteronomy 1:10-11 NASB

The final book of Moses allows us a glimpse of just how Moses’ forty-year walk with God had impacted his thinking as well as his faith. Having fled from Pharaoh and having had settled into a pastoral life, then being uprooted from that quiet life to lead God’s people for forty years, he now stands confident, not in his own abilities but in His God’s ability.

Small thinking and vision confine men who have little experience with God. Their hopes are bound by fears and relegated to the limits of their natural thoughts. But Moses... Moses had spoken face to face with Yahweh and had come away from the Awesome Presence a changed man! (Exodus 33:11). He had seen what others have not even hoped or dreamed about seeing. While most men wonder, Moses could say, “Now to Him by (in consequence of) the [action of His] power that is at work within us, is able [to carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly beyond our highest prayer, desires, thoughts, hopes or dreams...” (Ephesians 3:20 Amplified) From this perspective then, maybe even a multiplier of a thousand is too small!

Go ahead and dream big in God! No plan, no dream, no vision is too big if you are dreaming it with the Lord!
