



“You shall write them (*the Words of God*) on the door posts of your house and your gates.” Deuteronomy 6:9

The gates of ancient walled cities were strategic to their ready defense and protection. These gates were also critical to the flow of commerce and travel. When applied to our heart through study, memorization and meditation, the word of God mounts a sure guard over our hearts and lives. “Your word have I hidden in my heart, that I might no sin against You.” (Psalm 119:11) It is the word of God applied in and to our hearts that saves us.
