"And God heard their groaning... and God knew their plight." Exodus 2:24-25

There is a deep that calls to deep; a cry of the human heart that connects us with the heart of God.

Religious traditions hold that man cannot possible know what the LORD has in store for us. They may site, "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor has entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him." (1 Corinthians 2:9). Man's thinking will always fence God's good intentions from His people. "But God..." "But God has revealed them (the things which He has prepared for us), to us through His Spirit."
