Exodus 10:20

"But the LORD hardened Pharaoh's heart..." Exodus 10:20

We have seen that anguish of spirit and cruel bondage can cause men to harden their hearts. (Ex 6:9). A deep sorrow or disappointment may also harden a person's heart. (Job 6:10). Repetitive, willful sin will so gradually harden the human heart that its owner doesn't even perceive what is taking place until it is too late and calamity has overtaken him! (Proverb 28:14; 29:1; Romans 1 & 2; Hebrews 3:13).
