"And when they came to Marah, they could not drink the waters of Marah, for they were bitter... and the people murmured... and there He tested them." Exodus 15:22-24

Life is full of opportunities to become bitter. Life is also full of opportunities to complain. And, like it or not, life is a testing ground. "What is man, that You should magnify him, and that you should set Your heart upon him, and that You should visit him every morning, and test him every moment?" (Job 7:17-18)
