Ezra 5:4, 10

"Then local authorities, who were angry and threatened by the rebuilding of the Temple, asked *Zerubbabel and Jeshua*, "What are the names of the men who are working on this building?" And these local leaders also sent a letter to King Darius inquiring of him that, we have asked for the names of those building so that we might inform you and see who is chief among them." Ezra 5:4,10 paraphrased

Intimidation and threats are calculated to stop the work of God. The reality is that those Christians who have given themselves to prayer and are walking in the light of their calling – actively labouring for Jesus – are already known to the devil. "And the evil spirit answered and said, "Jesus I know, and Paul, I know, but who are you?" (Acts 19:15). Notwithstanding, don't rejoice in that the spirits are subject to you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven." (Luke 10:19-20)
