Ezra 9:8-9

"And now for a little moment grace has been shown from the LORD our God, to leave us a remnant to escape, and to give us a nail (*security*) in His holy place, that our God may lighten our eyes, and give us a little reviving in our bondage. For we were slaves; yet our God has not forsaken us in our bondage, but has extended mercy to us in the sight of the Kings of Persia, to give us a reviving, to set upon the house of God and to repair the desolations of it, and to give us a wall in Judah and in Jerusalem." (Ezra 9:8-9)
