



“And Abram believed the LORD, and the LORD declared him righteous because of his faith. Then the LORD told him, "I am the LORD who brought you out of Ur of the Chaldeans to give you this land." Throughout the Scriptures Yahweh reveals Himself through various covenant names. At each revelation of Himself the believer gains an access, not only to a broader understanding of God, but also to the benefits that are innately laden within that specific revelation of His character and Person!

And yet, so many Christians fail to realize in practical and tangible ways these rich benefits. In Genesis chapter fifteen, we see the LORD initiating a covenant with Abram. As the sacrifices are awaiting the confirming fire of God’s presence, the sanctity of the covenant is challenged as vultures begin their descent upon that which is holy and the token of the covenant between Yahweh and Abram. Abram acts immediately to drive away these demonic emissaries.
