Ruth 2:21

"Then Ruth the Moabitess said, "Furthermore, he said to me, 'You should stay close to my servants until they have finished all my harvest."" Ruth 2:21

The LORD's abundant provision for Ruth and Naomi was manifest as Ruth stayed close to the harvest fields. Boaz had given specific instruction to his field workers to leave extra grain for Ruth to glean. (Ruth 2:15) There is something about the harvest that God takes special care to guard and bless.
