Nehemiah 4:7-9

"When Sanballet and Tobiah heard that the repairing of the wall of Jerusalem went forward, and the breaches began to be closed, they were angry... and conspired to fight against Jerusalem and to hinder it. Nevertheless, we made our prayer unto our God, and set a watch against them day and night..." Nehemiah 4: 7-9
