Nehemiah 4:17-18

"They who built on the wall, and they who bore burdens, burdened themselves; everyone with one of his hands in the work and with his other hand holding a weapon. The builders had their swords by their sides as *they continued* building. And he who sounded the trumpet was by me." Nehemiah 4:17-18
