Nehemiah 6:5-14

"Then Sanballet sent his servant... a fifth time... and *in a written threat* said, "It is reported... that you and the Jews intend to rebel – that is why you built the wall so that you may be their king. And that you have appointed prophets to proclaim... "there is a king in Jerusalem!" "Then *Nehemiah* sent to Sanballet saying... "you invent these things in your own heart." For their intent was to make us afraid. Now Nehemiah prayed, "Therefore O God, strengthen our hands." Afterward...(the enemy) then hired a prophet to encourage Nehemiah to hide. And I said, "Should such a man as I flee? I will not..." Therefore he was hired, that I should be afraid and sin, and that the enemy might have an evil report concerning me." "My God think upon these enemies and false prophets, who would put me in fear." Nehemiah 6:5-14

Those who know their God, and know who they are in Christ, pose the greatest threat to the kingdom of darkness. "But the people that know their God shall be strong and do exploits!" (Daniel11:32b) Satan challenged Jesus on this point; "If You are the Son of God..." (Matthew 4:3, 6).
